2025 Water Restrictions

Due to severe drought conditions, the Antonito Town Board at the February 13, 2025 regular meeting imposed a **Level 2** outdoor water restriction effective March 1, 2025.

Level 2: Limitation of two days of outdoor watering from 6:00 AM until 9:00 AM and from 5:00 PM until 10:00 PM and not otherwise. Water users within Zone 1 shall be restricted to such use on Thursdays and Saturdays. Water users within Zone 2 shall be restricted to such use on Fridays and Sundays and not otherwise.

Zone 1 is defined as all property located North of 8th Avenue.

Zone 2 is defined as all property located South of 8th Avenue.

- 1. Any water consumer who violates this ordinance, upon the first time of such offense, shall be given a warning, either in writing or orally, by designated town employee or officer.
- 2. Any water consumer who violates this Ordinance or any part thereof on a second occasion, following the receipt of a warning will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
- 3. Third offense will be a \$75.00 fine.
- 4. Fourth offense will be a \$100.00 fin
- 5. In addition to the other enforcement mechanisms provided by this Ordinance, any person convicted of three violations, water will be disconnected from the property until fines are paid in full.

Recycling Drop-off Site Closed

Due to illegal dumping and after hours trespassing, The Antonito Recycling Dropof Site and Branch pit will be closed until further notice. Administrator Duran will be having several work sessions with mayor & trustees to come up with a solution to reopen the drop site. In the meantime, please contact the Antonito Town Hall for information on curbside pickup.

Unlawful Parking on Town Right of Way

During the past year, the Antonito Code Enforcement Department has been issuing several warnings regarding unlawful parking on the Towns Right of Way. Per Ordinance, inoperable vehicles, camper trailers, trailers, semi-trucks and other equipment are not allowed to be parked on the Towns Right of Way. In 2025, such vehicles, camper trailers, trailers, semi-trucks, and other equipment will be towed at the owner's expense.



Antonito Municipal Shop



Antonito Municipal Shop construction was completed in February. Antonito Public Works, over the years, has purchased several pieces of equipment that no longer fit in the existing shop. The new shop is an 8,000 Sq Ft building located at 511 Spruce St. The building project was designed and overseen by Atencio Engineering, General Contractor was Robins Construction and sub-contractors were Adam Gray Construction, Torres Plumbing & Heating, and Canty Electric. IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Town of Antonito Public Notice

Antonito had the following Violations Identified During a Drinking Water Inspection

Our water system recently violated a drinking water requirement. Although this situation is not an emergency, as our customers you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

A routine drinking water inspection conducted on January 14, 2025 by the state drinking water program identified the following violations that may pose a risk to public health.

Identified Violation	Date Correction is Required	Steps We Are Taking
M611-Supplier has permitted a cross connection	May 31, 2025	The Town of Antonito will control the cross connections.

 Uncontrolled cross connections can lead to a back pressure or siphonage event that may allow contaminants or disease-causing organisms to enter the drinking water, which can cause diarrhea, nausea, cramps, and associated headaches.

What does this mean? What should I do?

Antonito (Mansion) Town Hall Steps & Patio Project Nearly Completed

For the past few months, construction has been taking place in front of the Antonito Mansion. The project consists of demolition of existing steps and patio bricks and building new steps, brick patio, and ADA handicap ramp. The project is currently ongoing and we anticipate the completion by mid spring. The project is funded by a State Historical Society Grant and in part by SdCNHA. It is being constructed by Torres Builders, sub-contractor Robins Construction and others. We continue to ask for your patience during construction and would like you to continue using the rear entrance of the building.



Attention Vacant Buildings Owners!!!

In the past couple of years, transients, drug addicts, and homeless persons have been breaking into and making themselves at home in vacant buildings within Antonito. Antonito Mayor and Trustees would like owners to properly secure vacant buildings and post "No Trespassing" on vacant properties. Administrator Duran recommends that owners of vacant buildings take a proactive approach to trespassers. Report trespassing to the sheriff's department immediately. The first two months of 2025, three vacant buildings have been demolished due to a nuisance issue caused by the homeless. A fourth building will be demolished within a week due to illegal drug activities, unsafe living conditions, and a health hazard.
